I also understand that classes may be cancelled due to emergencies and rescheduled and/or venue may be changed at any given time, although cancelled classes (cancelled classes that fall within the season date: which are shown in the Registration Pack) will be made up before the end of the year at the teacher/instructor's convenience. I understand there are no refunds if the dancer changes his/her mind after enrolling him/her. I understand that ALL FEES including the annual registration fee is non-refundable. I understand that classes falling on a public holiday, spring break, winter break and Pro-D Days are forfeited. I understand that classes may need to be taught by a student teacher or substitute teacher if the designated teacher is sick/away on business/ holiday, etc, without notice. I understand that the class instructor may need to change during the year without notice. I also understand that if the dancer's class is to take part in performances/ exams/ shows that it is the teacher's discretion whether or not they are ready & whether or not to include them in the event. GIFT OF DANCE CANADA - FEE STRUCTURE 2024/2025

I am happy to confirm that fees will remain the same as the 2023/24 season for this year with the exception of a \$5 increase for registration fees for new pupils. See below for the cost of lessons!

*Please note there will be an annual registration fee. \$35.00 per returning student (early registration closed on 15 July) or \$40.00 per new student Registration fee will be charged for a maximum of 2 dancers per family (Maximum \$80.00 per family. Immediate family only)
*If we cannot have our show at Osoyoos Secondary for some reason, then a recital fee will need to be implemented in order to afford the Venables Theatre. This will be determined once I know if we cannot get the high school for some reason.

*Costume fees for the recital will be \$85.00 per costume (1 costume per class). If I get costumes donated or find some second hand for a great deal, this cost could drop, but please budget for \$85.00 per costume. Some costumes may be rentals for less, but I will only know that at a later stage, depending on what I can find from colleagues.

Please note that many of the good costume companies are in the U.S. and the duty really cost a lot more than anticipated last year.

*Uniform fees – An updated uniform document will be sent out shortly. You will be able to order your class uniforms at the end of the summer like last year. This will take place on 2nd of September 2024. A used sale will likely take place before that. Date to be confirmed.

*Families with multiple children dancing at Gift Of Dance will receive a 5% discount for the child with the lower monthly fees. Those with more than 2 children dancing can please contact me for further information on additional discounts.

*Fees will be due on the 1st of each month for 10 months (September – June). If you need to arrange a different date, please let me know.

* Fees are worked out as an annual fee, divided into 10 equal payments, regardless of holidays / breaks.

Every month the fees remain the same from September 1st through to June 1st.

*Dancers going away on holiday for long periods are still required to pay for the full months fees as their spot in class is being held for them.

I cannot pro-rate people who are taking long holidays mid-season unless this is brought up at the time of registration.

*If late payment becomes a problem, we may need to start adding penalties for late fees, so please pay timeously to avoid this.

*Note that June fees also remain the full month of fees, even though we have stage rehearsals.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT A SEPARATE PAYMENT MUST PLEASE BE MADE FOR EACH FAMILY MEMBER*

AS PER REGISTRATION FORM – ANY UNPAID OR LATE ACCOUNTS MAY BE CHARGED LATE PAYMENT FEES AS MENTIONED ABOVE, AND IF PAYMENT IS STILL NOT MADE AFTER 30 DAYS, ACCOUNTS MAY BE HANDED OVER TO A DEBT COLLECTOR FOR COLLECTION. PARENTS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE EXTRA COSTS INCURRED FROM THIS WHICH WILL BE ADDED TO YOUR ACCOUNT IN ADDITION TO ANY LATE PENALTY CHARGES AS MENTIONED ABOVE.

AS PER REGISTRATION FORM – CANCELLATION POLICY IS ONE FULL MONTH'S NOTICE IN WRITING BY EMAIL, IN ADDITION TO ONE FULL MONTH'S FEES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THE DANCER ATTENDS CLASSES DURING THE NOTICE PERIOD.

PLEASE NOTE THAT "ONE <u>FULL</u> MONTH'S NOTICE" MEANS THE MONTH YOU GIVE YOUR NOTICE IN, PLUS THE MONTH FOLLOWING, UNLESS NOTICE IS GIVEN ON THE 1⁵⁷ OF THE MONTH IN WHICH CASE THAT IS THE 1 MONTH CANCELLATION FEE. FOR EXAMPLE IF NOTICE IS GIVEN ON 2ND OF OCTOBER, THEN OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER FEES ARE BOTH STILL DUE AS THE FULL MONTH'S NOTICE.

AS PER REGISTRATION FORM – CANCELLATION IN WRITING IS STILL REQUIRED IF CLASSES SHIFT TO AN ONLINE FORMAT
(THIS WOULD ONLY APPLY FOR SOMETHING LIKE A PANDEMIC, OR UNUSUAL CONTAGIOUS ILLNESS AS EXPERIENCED DURING COVID) AND THE DANCER DOESN'T
WISH TO CONTINUE FOR ANY REASON. CANCELLATION IN WRITING IS ALSO STILL REQUIRED IF THE SCHEDULE HAS TO CHANGE AND THE DANCER CAN NO LONGER
MAKE THE NEW CLASS TIME.

SUCH CANCELLATION IS ALSO SUBJECT TO ONE **FULL** MONTH'S NOTICE PERIOD.

MORE IMPORTANT INFO:

SEASON DATES:

A. Start date:

9 September 2024 – Classes will begin the 2nd week of school, to allow families a week to get back into the swing of things.

B. Holidays:

In general, there will be no classes on public holidays and Pro-D days, unless a make-up day is needed in the event I am sick, or have to cancel classes for some unforeseen circumstances. In this instance I might make use of a holiday, a Pro-D day, early dismissal day, or a Friday (currently no regular classes are scheduled for Fridays).

C. Winter Break – Parents are invited to attend your dancers' last class in each discipline before the winter break to have a look at your child's progress:

19 December – Last day of dance classes 6 January – Dance resumes

D. Spring break dates:

***IMPORTANT!!! Please note that spring break will be longer this year. This is part of the reason the fees have remained the same as last year despite the cost of living going up. You are getting 2 weeks less of classes for the year, but your payments will remain 10 equal payments from September 1st – June 1st. Please note that I may offer some extra lessons if I feel we are not as far along with our show work as I would like us to be by this point in the year. By registering you are agreeing to these new season dates.

13 March – Last day of dance classes14 April – Dance resumes

E. Provisional recital dates (This is not confirmed, but is what I would like if we are able to secure the venue, so it is depending on venue and sound/light technicians availability)

16-18 June - Stage rehearsals 19 June - Full dress rehearsal 20 & 21 June - Show days

F. End of year:

26 June – Last day of dance. This final week of classes is compulsory for dancers wishing to perform at Canada Day (optional, but highly encouraged performance). I will try and see what can be done about some shade for the dancers to wait under next time, as it was tough out in the sun!

G. End of year party:

27 June – Party time!

H. Canada day performance rehearsal in the park:

30 June – Placing rehearsal. Dancers will need to rehearse on the grass next time, as we had some "oopsies" this year because the kids did get a bit confused having never danced in that space and on that surface, and without all the dancers being available. So, I'm hoping to arrange a run through of the full show on the grass on the Monday.

RECITAL:

Last season, we held our show at **Osoyoos Secondary school** with much success! I'd like to hold it there again for the next one so that I can keep ticket costs low. I'm open to feedback from parents, and I'm open to looking into Venables again in the future as we grow, but for now I am happy with how it went at OSS, and love how close it is to the studio. I will be contacting them to try and secure dates for our show once school opens again. I'm aiming for a similar time frame as this year, which was the weekend before school closes (see season dates above). I know the Highschool will be doing a musical again this coming season, so I am not sure about the stage availability yet. If anyone has any concerns regarding the dates we had this year, please let me know. I know it's a busy time of year, but I think it worked quite well. We will likely do 2x shows again, one on the Friday and one on the Saturday. If there is a need for a 3rd show it would be an additional show as a matinee on the Saturday, but only if necessary.

CLASS FREQUENCY:

Some classes are held more than once a week.

Please see below for clarity on which classes are only once a week, and which ones are required to attend more than once.

HIP HOP: 1x class per week

Hip Hop has a different meaning to everyone! But as a teacher I can tell you that hip hop classes are often the most popular classes and the kids just LOVE it! These classes are fun and energetic. We will cover elements and inspiration from various genres in these classes including; locking, waacking, popping, breaking, house and more!

**UNIFORM - Black/white indoor sneakers (no street shoes allowed on the dance floor! Please ensure a designated pair of sneakers for dancing), Black hip hop pants or leggings or shorts. Gift of Dance T-shirts will be available for order in the fall. Hair tied up.

JAZZ: 2x classes per week

Our jazz classes cover a variety of styles/categories including Jazz, Lyrical, Modern, Body conditioning, and on occasion, a bit of Musical theatre. These classes are wonderful for technique, posture, strength, control and artistry. From grade 1 and older, dancers are required to take a minimum of 2x jazz classes per week. This allows us enough time to cover such a broad scope of work and get our standards high. One class a week is not enough to really develop technique and flexibility. We also need to work on show work and cannot sacrifice technical training to work on choreography alone.

**UNIFORM – Beige slip-on Jazz shoes (see uniform document), Black leggings/tights/hot pants and Black Gift of Dance leotard will be available for order towards the end of the summer! No loose fitting clothes. Hair must be tied off the face in a ponytail or bun (bun is best for technique classes as we need the hair secured when practicing turns). Girls may wear a fitted tank top during practices with hot pants or leggings.

TAP: 1x class per week

We get to use our feet as instruments and create not just a wonderful VISUAL dance but also something that appeals to our AUDIO senses! Of course, the tap students will also be working on technique plus recital routine work.

**UNIFORM - Black Tap shoes (at the recreational level, I recommend the slip-on ones from Movement boutique which helps with quick changes at recital time. Split sole tap shoes are NOT recommended), Black jazz pants/tights/shorts, fitted t-shirt or tank top or Gift of Dance leotard. Hair tied in a ponytail.

ACROBATIC ARTS: 1x class per week (in addition to 2x jazz or 2x ballet for those doing grade 2-4 or older)

Acro-Dance is offered purely as a supplement to add on to the jazz or ballet dancer's training. I am a certified Acrobatic Arts teacher and offer classes once per week to students from 5 years and up. Acro dancers doing grade 2-4 acro or higher, must participate in either x2 ballet or x2 jazz classes per week in order to be able to join our acro classes. We want this style of dance to add to our students' versatility. Grade 2 dancers can opt for the 5-7 years jazz or ballet which are both only offered once a week for this year and move to 2x per week from next year.

**UNIFORM – Black leggings/hot pants and Black leotard will be available for order in the fall! No loose-fitting clothes nor jewellery, nor long nails. Hair must be tied off the face for safety reasons, preferably in a low braid.

MUSICAL THEATRE: 1x class per week (in addition to 2x jazz or ballet)

This genre includes singing and acting as well as dancing! We will learn some singing techniques and songs, learn about different musicals and participate in acting exercises and games. As dance is the main focus for us, this class is also offered as a supplement to add on to the jazz or ballet dancer's training.

**UNIFORM - Black leggings/tights/shorts and Black Gift Of Dance leotard will be available for order at the end of summer! No loose fitting clothes. Hair must be tied off the face in a ponytail or bun. Girls may wear a fitted tank top during practices with hot pants or leggings.

BALLET: 2x classes per week

Ballet is an essential genre for any dancer wishing to pursue a career in dance, or just looking for a strong foundation and good technique. I highly recommend adding ballet to your dancer's schedule if they're interested in jazz, musical theatre and acro and even figure skating, as it will strengthen the other genres and support their training.

BOYS:

Boys uniforms will typically be black shorts or pants, and a fitted studio t-shirt for all genres other than Hip Hop, for which they can wear a baggy gift t shirt and other baggy clothing if they prefer.

COMPETITIONS:

I typically audition dancers for competition teams and solos and have a high expectation of how many hours the dancers will put into additional rehearsals for this (over and above their regular weekly classes). I have heard some of the dancers say they'd like to do solos and/or competitions, so I will be putting together all the requirements for this and interested parents will be able to send their child to the auditions (audition date to be confirmed). I am also looking into collaborating with other studios in the Okanagan to build a "set dance" competition for recreational dancers which I believe will help bridge the gap between dancing recreationally, and competitively. I am working on this and hope to have some further info on this soon!

OTHER:

Summer camps 2024 are on offer in July and August. Please contact me if you didn't receive this info and would like to send your child.

SEPTEMBER SCHEDULE:

A provisional schedule has been sent out, but please see below for the updated schedule (Version 3.5)noting a change for Grade 4 jazz and Grade 2/3 jazz on Mondays which was mentioned previously. Please also note that the 5-6 years classes have been changed to 5-7 years. The grade 2's will have the option of trying out the 5-7 years class if they found last year a bit too difficult to keep up. This schedule is still subject to changes based on registration. See the next page for the schedule.
